



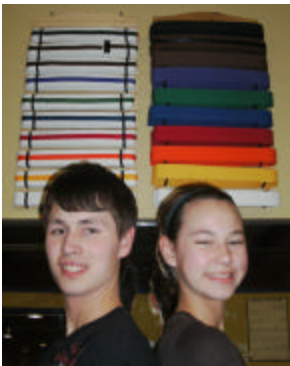

Evolution Not Revolution!

And yes, that means change is coming but we feel this truly is a case of "change for the better". We're updating our renewal procedures with systematic changes that will make renewing for class each term a bit more convenient, less cumbersome and more accurate for you and us. But there's no need to worry because everything is going to seem very familiar; we've chosen evolutionary improvements, not evolutionary upheaval.

There are 3 key points to this evolution of which you'll want to be aware as we move through this term.

- 1) **Will we still have "Terms" and "renewals"?** Top Flight's programs, going forward, should be thought of as year round activities with 2 sessions; the school session (formerly Fall I, Fall II, Winter and Spring) and the summer session. Payment for these sessions will be broken down into convenient 8 week pay periods (These will be replacing our previous 10 week terms). You will still receive a statement requesting payment for the next term by our Priority Payment Date (PPD) which will always be, Saturday ending the 6th week of the term. Sound Familiar? You will have until PPD to pay in full by any method you choose; cash, check, money order, credit or debit card.
- 2) **Well what's the difference other than an 8 week pay period?** Each family will also be required to keep on file a bank account or credit/debit card. If you choose not to make a regular payment, tuition for the next term will be processed automatically (by charge or EFT) on that term's PPD. No more worries about missing PRD!
- 3) **Prefer to pay on a more budget friendly schedule?** Simply tell us when you register for either of Top Flight's 2 sessions (school year or summer) and we'll put you on our Auto Pay Program, charging your card or drawing funds from your bank account on predetermined dates every 4 weeks.

If you choose to "unenroll" please give us a 1 week notice so we don't charge your card or account on PPD. Your child will be placed on priority renewal status and receive special notice of our PPD (priority payment date) for the following term.

Like we said Evolution not Revolution.

- 2 sessions per year: no more constant renewals
- 8 week Pay Periods: easier on your wallet
- Choice of Payment: any method you choose by PPD
- Auto Pay options: no more missing a PPD or a budget friendly 4 week payment.

We think you'll find this evolution similar to our current 10 week terms (with a P.R.D.) but enhanced; more reasonable pay periods and automatic payment options for convenience and peace of mind.
